GHFA Seeking Applicants For First Cycle 2022 Community Health Grant Awards Program

Deadline to Apply for First Cycle 2022 Funding is February 1, 2022

The Georgia Healthy Family Alliance (GHFA) is currently seeking applications for the first cycle of the 2022 Community Health Grant Awards program. Grant awards of up to \$5,000 are made to GAFP member affiliated community organizations that support program priorities including underserved populations and community projects that promote healthy practices consistent with the principles of Family Medicine. Current GAFP members including medical students, residents and active/ life members are eligible to apply. **The application deadline for first cycle 2022 awards is February 1st.** First cycle grant awards will be announced in March 2022.

Over the last eight years, the Community Health Grant Program has given over \$500,000 in grants back to GAFP members, residency programs, FMIG groups and their communities including Wellstar Kennestone Family Medicine for the “Let’s Get Moving” Pedometer Project:
