

AAFP DUES CANCELLATION DATE CHANGE THIS YEAR

New this year, the American Academy of Family Physicians has changed the date to both pay your 2022 dues AND report CME to **March 3, 2022**. This is much earlier than the previous April 30 deadline.

If your CME reporting cycle ended on December 31, 2021, and you have not yet reported all your CME credits for the past 3-year cycle, please do so by March 1.

CME requirements are as follows:

To be eligible for Active membership, AAFP requires 150 credits of CME to be completed during your three-year re-election cycle. At least 75 of those must be AAFP Prescribed credits.

Most often, when members are short of the required credits, it is just a case of not reporting all possible credits or simply incorrect reporting.

If you have not paid your dues, for your convenience there are two ways to pay:

- Log on to the AAFP website (www.aafp.org) and pay your dues online. Make sure you have your membership ID and password handy!
- Call the AAFP Contact Center at (800) 274-8043, press 0, and tell them you want to pay your dues.
