## Rules to Roll

Help the WheelShare program be a success by following these guidelines.  
Remember, you have to be 18 to rent a WheelShare bike or scooter.

- **Know Your Location**  
In downtown, ride in the bike lane or street.
- **Watch Your Speed**  
Speed is limited to 15 mph and reduced to 7 mph in Riverfront Park.
- **Ride Safely**  
Wear a helmet and watch for pedestrians.







# Relatable Key Issues

- Limited Geofencing (speed zones) capacity
- Continued voice in favor of bikes
- State Park jurisdiction overlap

Downtown Spokane is Restricted for sidewalk use by bike, scooter, or skateboard.


