FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who should your company nominate for the exclusive Emerging Leaders Conference?

Nominate an employee that has eight or more years' cumulative professional experience (in any industry). The nominee should be a high performer that is making an impact in your company or your community and has strong leadership potential. It is our intention to bring a new group of emerging leaders in each year to benefit from this professional development opportunity so we ask that you do not re-nominate a 2022 Emerging Leader.

Who should complete the nomination form for the Emerging Leaders Conference?

A senior leader in your organization should identify a high performer in your company and complete the online nomination form.

How will the nominee benefit from attending the Emerging Leaders Conference?

Emerging Leaders Conference attendees will receive recognition for their contributions to your company and community and will grow both professionally and personally. The Emerging Leaders Conference will help energize the next generation of leaders as they receive professional development training and a toolkit of resources to bring back to your company. Participants will have an opportunity to network and learn best practices on a variety of topics from executive industry leaders and speakers.

Are there certain job functions that should be considered when choosing a nominee?

Does it matter where a nominee lives?

Can more than one person from a company be nominated for the Emerging Leaders Conference?

Yes, you can nominate multiple rising stars and talent from any discipline for the Emerging Leaders Conference. Please be aware that while we would like to allow all nominees the opportunity to attend, there is limited space at the event. Nominees will go through a selection process and not all will be chosen.

When and where will the Emerging Leaders Conference be held?

The Emerging Leaders Conference will be held on Sunday, February 5 - Tuesday, February 7, 2023 at the Emeline Hotel in Charleston, South Carolina.

If our nominee is chosen, what is the registration fee for the nominee?

Registration for the Emerging Leaders Conference is \$799 and includes the Sunday opening reception, the conference general sessions, the Monday breakfast, luncheon, reception and dinner, and the Tuesday breakfast. Travel and hotel costs are not included.

What is the deadline for submitting nominations for the Emerging Leaders Conference?

All nominations are due by close of business on Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

When will nominees be notified if they are selected to attend the Emerging Leaders Conference?

Announcements of selected nominees will begin in November of this year with the nominator being notified prior to the nominee.
