- The deadline for abstract submission is **Friday 12 April 2019 (11:59 pm AEST)**
- **Abstracts can only be submitted via email to the FAMS2019 Organising Committee at info@allergenbureau.net**
- Please adhere strictly to the style indicated in the Abstract Template provided (see final page)
- The presenting author of each abstract must be highlighted (underlined) in the abstract.
- Abstract must not exceed 300 words
- It is the authors' responsibility to submit a correct abstract; any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific fact will be reproduced as typed by the authors, if the abstract is accepted
- Abstracts must be submitted in .doc or docx format only
- Please save your abstract using the file name as follow: Author LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME_ORAL/POSTER (state one preference). For example: SMITH_MARY_POSTER.doc
- Please ensure that you indicate your preference (Oral or Poster) in the file name
- The presenting author of each abstract must be registered for FAMS2019. The registration fee is refundable if the abstract is not accepted by the FAMS2019 Organising Committee. However, no refund will be granted in the case of cancellation by the authors
- It is accepted to be the presenting author of more than one abstract and a co-author of an unlimited number of abstracts
- Since there are a limited number of oral contributions, despite your stated preference, your submitted abstract maybe considered for a poster by the FAMS2019 Organising Committee
