FCAAP Region 2 Representative

All members running for a position on the Board of Directors shall have been a voting member of, and in good standing with, this organization for at least a two-year period, with one year of active committee service within one year of the election. Regional representatives shall practice in the elective region.

The Bylaws provide for the counties within each region:

The Bylaws set forth the responsibilities and duties of Regional Representatives:

1. Regional representatives shall be available for appointment to committees, councils, and task forces of the organization and may be requested by the President to be the organization's local representative to the media when issues of importance arise. In such instances, the Representative designated by the President shall take care to ensure that the official position of the organization is appropriately represented
2. The Representatives shall promote membership through active service on the Membership Committee.
3. Representatives shall serve as ambassadors to non-members and convey information regarding the initiatives, goals, and missions of the organization.
4. Representatives shall make a concerted effort to represent the organization by attending local and regional meetings, and shall inform members and non-members about the activities of the organization, highlighting the benefits of membership.
5. Representatives shall be available to respond to issues regarding the health and welfare of infants, children, adolescents, and young adults in Florida, and to coordinate local and national resources when possible.
